ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must have earned your **Eagle Scout Rank**.
- 2. Must have continued to be active with Troop 111 either as a Scout or Scouter until graduation.
- 3. Provide a copy of the acceptance letter from an accredited University/College/Institute of Higher Learning.
- 4. Community service is a major element of being a good Scout in any rank. Applicant must have a minimum of 100 community service hours, 30 of which must be in direct service to CAFCI (Toys for Tots Project, Relay for Life, MLK Flag Ceremony, Cultural Diversity Day Flag Ceremony etc.) and a minimum of 30 hours in service to other Eagle Scouts at their projects.
- 5. The **Order of the Arrow** is the official Honor Society of the Boy Scouts of America. Applicant must be active **Brotherhood member** and/or **Vigil Honor** in the Aal-Pa-Tah Lodge.
